

# HARRINGTONWINES

## 2009 PINOT NOIR, RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY

Usually blended from barrels sourced from a number of different Russian River vineyards, the 2009 wine is made from a single, sustainably-grown vineyard located west of Windsor. The soils are gravelly-loam formed from the ancient deposits of the nearby Star Creek, a tributary of the Russian River. Although it is not certified organic, many organic protocols are currently being utilized in this small-grower vineyard. Yields were less than two tons per acre in 2009.

Two separate harvest picks insured perfect ripeness and moderate sugars.
